

RACC with Electrocat

Last 3 June, RACC took part in the prize-giving ceremony of the event ElectroCat, organised by the Town Council of Santa Perpetua de la Mogoda and other towns of the area of La Riera de Caldes, in order to promote electric mobility in the territory. Five of the eight teams made-up of automotive students from vocational training schools in Catalonia, who took part in the 4th edition of the ElectroCat contest, put the electric vehicle prototypes that they had build during the last school year to the test on an urban circuit.

ElectroCat is a contest during which higher-education students from educational centres in Catalonia design and build an electric vehicle based on a common engine design (engine, converter and batteries), which is then assessed as regards the performance, features and design of the vehicle.

The aim of the contest is basically to promote teamwork among the students and to strengthen the experimental and creative activity as a pedagogical element to get deeper technical knowledge about electric vehicles. In this sense, the contest aims to become a platform for the training and promotion of technicians specialised in electrically driven vehicles to cover the needs that have arisen out of the new mobility model, based on electric vehicles.

The winner of this edition was the school IES Palau Susit from Ripollet, which was awarded by the RACC with 15 tickets to attend the Motorcycling Grand Prix.
